Oil refunds now available

Farmers, business and others who use large quantities of petroleum products and were injured as a result of pricing violations are eligible to apply for refunds.

According to the Kentucky Energy Cabinet, at least \$80 million has been set aside by the U.S. Department of Energy from a recent court settlement to provide direct restitution to consumers injured by oil company overpricing from 1973 to 1981.

This oil overcharge settlement paid is different from other oil overcharge settlements made previously received by the states. The federal courts have made this process available for refund to consumers who had been injured by the overpricing during this period.

Under the court settlement, about \$40 million will be refunded for every 100,000 gallons of petroleum products used during this eight year period.

The U.S. Department of Energy is handling the refund process and has established a minimum refund. A minimum must be purchased and 18.70 gallons in order to get a refund.
