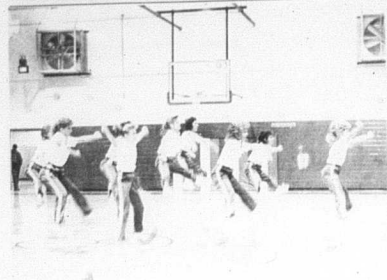

He was a native of Nicholas County, the son of the late George Billy Fryman, a retired farmer.

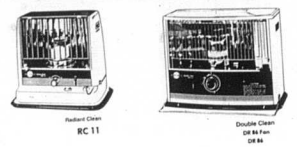
