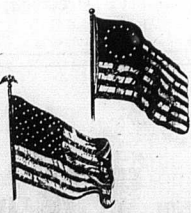

#### Hamm graduates

Margaret Ellen Hamm of Carlisle received the bachelor of arts degree with high honor May 15 at Agnes Scott College in Decatur, Georgia.

A chemistry major at Agnes Scott, Hamm was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, was on the Dean's List and the Honor Roll, and was named to Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges.

In addition, she was Dana Schuler, a member of Mortar Board and Interdisciplinary Council president. She won the Agnes Scott Analytical Chemistry Award in 1986 and the Pierson and Clarke Chemistry Fellowship for summer research in 1985.

Hamm has been awarded a President's Fellowship at the Georgia Institute of Technology beginning with the summer quarter, 1987.

President's Fellowships are offered annually to a select number of highly qualified students who intend to pursue advanced degrees, preferably to the doctoral level.

Hamm is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James A. Hamm of Carlisle and is a graduate of Bourbon County High School.

#### Letcher makes presentation

Two Morehead State University undergraduate students recently presented research papers at the Carolina Psychology Conference held in Raleigh, North Carolina.

They were Dawn Letcher, Carlisle sophomore, and James Rowlett, Newbern, North Carolina, junior honors student.

Serving as co-authors of the work were graduate students Billie Jo Hutton of Whitesburg and John White of Clarksville, West Virginia.

The papers dealt with behavioral effects of long term use of drugs which alter synaptic chemistry.

The research is part of an ongoing project supported by a NSF Research and Patient Committee grant to Dr. Bruce A. Mattingly, associate professor of psychology.

Participation of the students at the conference was made possible by support from the University's Honors Program and the College of Professional Studies.
