Blackberries fill vines on Shumate's "Orphan Farm"

By Jessie H. Duncan to the Carlisle Mercury Staff. The sweetest soil on Windstone Farm's "Orphan Farm" was produced in a field of blackberries. All of it is on a research field of one and one-half acres with a future as the cherry berry as it grows.

Wayne Shumate, owner of Windstone Farm, hopes his success will be an incentive for Nicholas County farmers to try blackberry farming as an auxiliary crop for tobacco. He has a total of 12 and one-half acres of blackberries, and has planted another five acres.

Shumate is hoping a station will be located in Nicholas County. He could see Nicholas, Robertson and Bath. Shumate's wife, Kay, came up with an idea that has streamlined the picking process.

The two and one-half acre research field, which was planted three years ago, has 2,000 plants.
