Wednesday, March 4, begins the Lenten season. Lent is the period of forty days preceding Easter beginning on Ash Wednesday and concluding on Saturday before Easter.
The observance of the Lenten season begins during the fourth or fifth century as a result of early Christian efforts to find ways to deepen the devotional approach to Easter. Periods of fasting and preparation for Easter a few hours to many days were developed. By the middle of the 12th century there was general agreement on a period of forty days.
