**by National Mother's Day Committee**

For the ninth consecutive year, the National Mother's Day Committee has announced its list of Outstanding Mothers. The Honorees for 1987 were presented at a luncheon ceremony in New York on April 24th.

The Mothers singled out for the distinctive Outstanding Mother Award were chosen for their contribution of ideas, skills and interests that have made them role models for the rest of us in today's complex social structure - but only have they been great mothers, but they have given themselves through recognition by our society, for their contributions above and beyond the home alone.

As more and more mothers find their way into business, science, the arts and engineering, child rearing and learning facilities, the full extent of their sacrifices and dedication to the community is only now being fully appreciated.

Mothers who when the Honorees were bestowed embrace interests and activities that open the entire spectrum of our organized society. They are Congresswoman Linda Biagini of the State of Louisiana, Evelyn Lander, Business Executive and Philanthropist, Linda Larkin, Actress, Miss America '78, and a child care professional, Internationally Recognized Performing Artist and Stage, Screen & TV, Dr. Douglas Valois, Nobel Prize Winner for Medicine.

List presented in 1979, the Outstanding Mother Awards have come to represent a benchmark by which we all

measure the achievements of this new generation of women who actively manage the business of home, and a touch in the work force, to help construct a stronger and better national society.

In recognizing these role model mothers, the National Mother's Day Committee recognizes all American mothers and wishes through the annual O.M.A. Awards to take full cognizance of the expanded responsibilities women in today's full time mothers job holders, who are 90% approved more than 65 percent of all mothers in the country.

Mr. Ronald G. Kraft, President of the National Mother's Day Committee, and Executive Vice President of Frederick Adams, Inc., advised, "I'm not a mother, but I'm married to one."

"I know, first hand, what the fun is to put up with just staying in step with my schedule, while keeping the family on line and staying a household that will survive the trials of all of us."

"She leads a dual life, too, though she is as kept in the work force. Her reward is after a tiring day at the home, to sit in a car, work that consumes all much of her and her time as would a full time job."

"She makes me realize how much we depend on our mothers to keep our society on an even keel, whether the waters are smooth or rough."

Says Carolyn Welch, Chairperson of the Outstanding Mother Award Comm-

tee, "Mothering was once a full time, costly time profession. But, as recent years, as the demands of the family have become greater, as more families work the yard job and more women work for complete fulfillment on the dual side of home-maker and careerist, demands on mothers have escalated along with pressures coming from driving double-duty."

As our mother appreciation program grows, we are sure it will be a great pleasure to tell them that they have not sacrificed for us in vain, as a most appropriate response to a grateful society.

After all, where would we be if it were not for the mothers of the world who have us - and brought us the message of life?

The Outstanding Mother Awards were presented in New York at the Madison Center Hotel. About 300 guests from

government, committee and industry, education, religion and the sciences attended the ceremonies.
