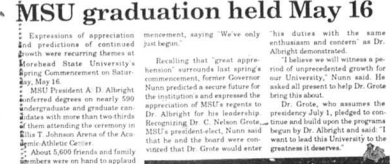

District judges Wayne Fitzgerald and Robert McGinnis of the 18th Judicial District attended a program on the unified juvenile code held at the Owensboro Executive Inn, May 13-15.

The Kentucky unified Juvenile Code, passed by the 1986 General Assembly and applicable throughout the state, creates 10 new chapters in the Kentucky Revised Statutes...

Another goal is to assure each child a safe and nurturing home and to remove them from their homes only when less restrictive alternatives have failed or are not feasible.

While treatment instead of punishment, family integrity, and diversion from the court system are major Code themes, harsh consequences that prevent early release are also spelled out in some circumstances.
