Kentucky Department of Transportation has announced that KY 57, the Thru-Nicholas County line road in Bourbon County will be closed for almost replacement 1/2 mile south from its junction with KY 1198 at mile post 19.7 from Monday, June 1 through Thursday, June 4. The road will reopen on Friday, June 5. No detour will be signed.

According to Jim Brown, chief district engineer, the Kentucky Department of Highways plans to replace a structure located on KY 22 in Nicholas County 400 east of US 68 over Brantly Creek.  
The new structure will be a 14 x 98' pipe arch culvert.  
It will be necessary to close KY 22 at this location on June 1 for approximately one month. A detour will be provided via US 68 (also AA); via KY 165 (also A) and via KY 22 (also AA).
