The program works as a cycle, explained Sharon Williams, vice principal of Nicholas County Elementary.
The children work on computer with partners and must complete 10 cycles involving learning 42 different phonemes. This helps translate taking time writing. After learning of the phonemes is completed he or she may work on the computer work journal. The children do work on their own and at least 100 minutes a day are completed, said Williams.
The program also involves a typing station or manipulative learning center after the child is started on the phonemes he or she has already learned.
Manipulative learning is written on subject the student has picked (written work journal), or arranging blocks to make words. The student may visit an interactive and verbally answer questions.
Right to Read is a real live. This means the child can check out books and solve traditional book reading on their writing level.
