One of the most frustrating problems faced by parents of infants through the age of two is sleepless nights. Usual sleep disorders of babies include night crying, frequent night waking, and fussing.

Most babies should be sleeping at night for four to five months. After that, the night should be a peaceful hour or so. A baby who does not sleep at night is a sign of a physical problem.

In extreme situations, the parent can call the pediatrician. The pediatrician will not rest until the cause of the problem is found. It is a good idea to call the pediatrician if the baby is not sleeping at night.
