Labor Day drivers use extra caution
Kentucky State Police and local law enforcement agencies are urging drivers to exhibit extra care during the Labor Day Holiday driving hours. The first Labor Day Holiday period begins at 8 p.m., Friday, September 4, and continues through 11 midnight, Monday, September 7.

During the three day weekend period last year, seven fatal crashes were reported in Kentucky. In ten other crashes, 10 people lost their lives. The youngest victim was 13 years old, and the oldest 67 years old. Six of the 10 killed were drivers, and four killed were passengers. One of the victims was partially ejected.

Nine of the 10 victims were using no safety restraints. Five of the 10 victims were killed in crashes where the driver was drinking. Four of the seven crashes were alcohol related. Two of the seven accidents were reported in the area. One person was killed in a crash in Montgomery County on Kentucky 191, and in Bath County another person lost their life in an accident on Kentucky 1325.
