Louisville football program looking for consistency

Louisville, Ky. (AP) — Plugging a porous defense that surrendered nearly 400 yards and more than 30 points per game last year is the main concern for Louisville Coach Howard Schnellenberger heading into spring football practice.

"Had our defense been as far along as our offense last year, we probably would have won another three games," Schnellenberger said of the disappointing 3-7 campaign. "So, obviously, as we get to work hard on the defense."

Even though 10 defensive starters return, none has a special award, Schnellenberger said. As a result, each practice session should be extremely competitive.

"That's the beauty of spring practice," the coach said. "You give everybody a chance to compete and challenge for a starting position. By the end of practice, you know who the best is at each position."

The Cardinals began spring drills last Monday. NCAA regulations allow five practice days in events and 18 days of contact work. But Schnellenberger said he has never used the full allotment to his more than three years on the job.

"We always get in 16 or 17. You always get a lot of simulated, first- or second-quarter, so it's hard to get 20," he said.

The most intense battle may be at quarterback, where five players will be vying for the three spots on the depth chart behind incumbent Jay Gruden. The candidates — all of whom played on the scout team last year — are Bob Nix and Browning Nagle, transfers from Maryland and West Virginia, and redshirt freshmen Joey Creshaw, Brian Browning and Erik Wata.

Kentucky coach not surprised in first scrimmage

LEXINGTON, Ky. (AP) — University of Kentucky football Coach Jerry Claiborne said he was not surprised Saturday that his team completed one of 13 practice scrimmages of the spring football drills.

For the offense, Alfreo Rawls, a 6-foot-11, 260-pound transfer from Northeastern Oklahoma A & M, ran for 53 yards on 10 carries, including a four-yard touchdown run.

Senior Tim Smith had 45 yards on 10 carries and senior Ivy Joe Hunter had 32 yards on eight carries. Senior quarterback Glenn Fisher completed six of 13 passes for 40 yards and junior Chuck Brughton was three of seven for 39 yards. Both threw a one interception.

Tight end Charlie Darrington led the Wildcats receivers with four catches for 31 yards.
