**State cracking down**

A crack down on delinquent taxpayers by the Revenue Cabinet produced over \$600,000 in a 14-week period this year.

The Revenue Cabinet contacted 13 seizures from March to July 14 under its Distraint and Levy (D & L) Program. The D & L is a last resort measure against delinquent taxpayers. The program allows the Revenue Cabinet to seize financial assets of seriously delinquent taxpayers such as bank accounts, accounts receivable, unpaid salaries, and tangible property such as vehicles and real estate. "We owe it to the taxpayers and the state to collect delinquent taxes from those who will not pay," says Revenue Cabinet Secretary C. Ernest Calvert. The Revenue Cabinet will use all the resources available to us to collect taxes due to the state. Calvert emphasizes that the Distraint and Levy Program is a last resort.
