Dollar General planning Carlisle opening, Aug. 25

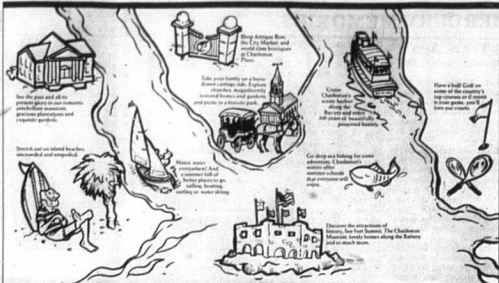

 A Dollar General Store will open in Carlisle August 25, said District Manager Bill Mullins.
 This Tuesday Frankie Johnson, James Hill and Perry Fishback were working to set up the store by next Thursday.
 Mullins agreed that they were setting up the store quickly. Although the square footage couldn't be found, the store will have two floors. Down stairs will be for hardware and shoes, Mullins said. Dollar General Stores' 134 E. Main.

New child support law was effective July 15

Immediate wage assignments and mandatory jail sentences are part of the new Kentucky child support law that went into effect July 15, 1988, according to Nicholas County Attorney Joseph H. Conley, who officiates child support enforcement for Nicholas County.
 All child support orders, including divorce decrees, will now include provisions for automatic wage assignments unless good cause is shown. In other words, any employee who is ordered to pay child support will have the support automatically withheld from his wage by his employer, unless he can show good cause why this should not be done.
 The employer may deduct \$1.60 for each payment made pursuant to the order to cover its administrative expenses. The wage assignment for child support shall have priority as against any attachment, execution or wage assignment, unless otherwise ordered by the court.
 When an obligor is convicted of non-support the second time, he shall receive a minimum of seven days in jail, and a minimum of 30 days in jail for the third, fourth or fifth offense.
 Plaintiff non-support, which is the failure to pay child support resulting in an arrearage of \$1,000.00 or more, six consecutive months without payment of support, is punishable by from one to five years in the penitentiary.
 Child support obligations are being taken seriously by the federal, state and local governments, and by the courts Conley stated, and we intend to continue doing all we can to see that the responsible parents support owed is paid. These new laws should help us do our job better, he said.
