
WADK

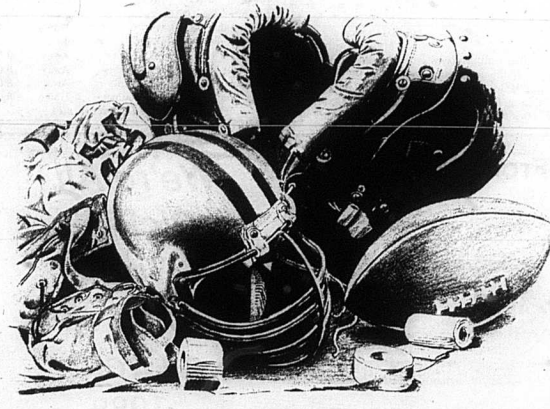
