**For season's first win
Nicholas rolls to win over Deming**

CARLISLE - Nicholas County rolled to a 9-0 lead in the first period of play and went up to claim a 16-0 basketball victory Friday night.

Before a near capacity crowd the Bluejackets opened scoring on a 15 foot shot by Daniel Brown from the left side. Brian Hillander hit one of two free throws, Andy Anderson canned a 15 foot shot from the right. Brown hit again, and with 5:20 to play Anderson fielded an assist from Brown and hit from six feet out to give the hosts a 6-0 advantage.

Mike Cooper hit from six feet to get the Devils into the scoring column and he was fouled on the shot by Hillander.

Cooper's attempt at a three point play was no good as his free throw rimmed out and Nicholas County took center court.

With 4:12 to play in the opening stanza, Brown hit from three point land and Nicholas County took a 12-2 lead.

Mike McKinney took a Deming timeout and the Devils responded in kind.

Billy Kaiser notched six unanswered points to cut the Nicholas County lead to 12-8.

With 2:04 to play in the quarter, Mark Mann hit one of two free throws to cut the Nicholas margin to 12-9, but the Jackets pulled away to lead 17-10 at the first stop.

Deming stayed within striking distance for most of the second quarter, trimming the Nicholas advantage to

HEALTHY EYES, IMPERFECT VISION

Few people have perfect vision, although most have healthy eyes. By the mid-40's it's common to need glasses or contact lenses to see a correct vision defect.

The four most common types of functional vision defects are:

- **Farsightedness (hyperopia)** - A great effort is required to see close work clearly, or images appear blurred. Headaches may be common after reading.
- **Nearsightedness (myopia)** - Objects appear blurred at a distance. Usually vision is clear for close tasks such as reading.
- **Astigmatism** - Mirshape of the cornea causes distorted images, especially when combined with nearsightedness or farsightedness.
- **Presbyopia** - The gradual loss of focusing ability is usually noticed between the ages of 40 and 50, when vision at normal reading distances begins to blur.

All these defects are correctable by eyeglasses or contact lenses.

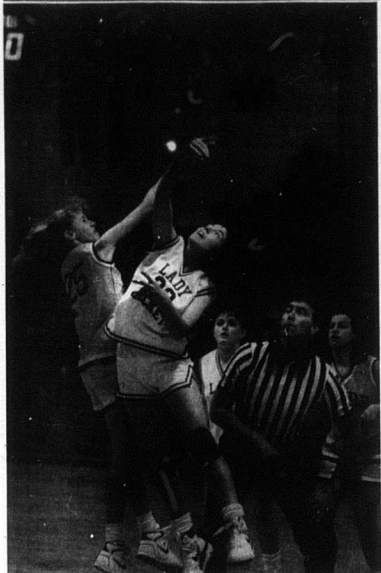

The Jackets led 17-6 at the first stop, after jumping out to an 8-0 lead.

Strong inside play and tough defense propelled Nicholas County to a 39-11 lead at intermission.

The third quarter was more of the same, as Nicholas County out scored visiting Sayre 14-4, and it was the same in the fourth with the Lady Jackets taking a commanding 20-7 advantage in the last eight minutes.

Smooth finished with five steals and four assists, and Earlswe had eight rebounds to add to her game total.
