DANVILLE, Ky. (AP) - Michael F. Adams, vice president of university affairs at Pepperdine University in California, will be named president of Centre College within the next two weeks, according to a published report.

The Advocate-Messenger of Danville reported Wednesday that Adams will replace Richard L. Merrill, who left Sept. 30 after six years at Centre to become president of the University of Richmond in Virginia.

William H. Bressa has been serving as interim president. Adams, 40, has been vice president and professor of political communications at Pepperdine since 1982, said Roddy Wolper, director of public information at the Malibu, Calif., university.

Adams acknowledged Wednesday that he was one of the finalists, and that he recently had visited Centre's campus in Danville.

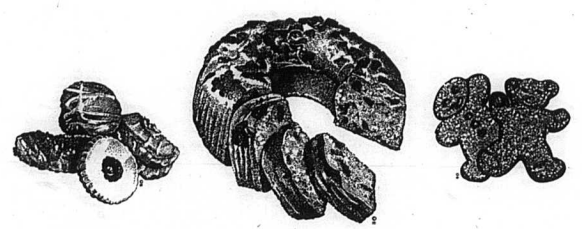
