For 75 years Latta Holtz has written the Saltwell News for The Carlisle Mercury.
Mary does not know that writing a weekly news column is a family tradition for the Holtz family.
Holtz's father, E. G. Matton lived over for E. G. Matton in 1913.
That began writing after he and my mom Lucy Rose Matton moved into the new house from their old log cabin across the creek," said Holtz.

"I can remember dad writing on Sunday afternoon," Holtz said.
When he got older and was unable to write I would come over and he would tell me just what he wanted to say and I would write it and send it in," Holtz said.

"When Matt was the reporter for the Saltwell News all the precincts in the county were a similar column.
Tom Hill, East Union, Moorefield, Ball Hill and Headquarters were just a small part of the columns that were written by one of the residents of each small part of the Nicholas County," said Holtz.

Matt wrote for a total of 58 years.
Mrs. Holtz wrote for three years and she lived at her home before his death.

"The phone rings off the wall most days and I compile the special happenings that take place in our part of the world.
Also, people in town can call when they visit friends or relatives in Saltwell.
