New recording business opens; restaurant purchased

The Carlisle Highway near Bright Lights and Big City have come to Carlisle.

Big name entertainment has moved into downtown in the name of a new business and that new industry has brought.

Jim Kelley, a native of Nashville, Tennessee who now resides in Lexington, has opened Country Road Recording, Promotion and Power Publishing.

Kelley, involved in the recording business for over 23 years, will be booking, promoting, recording, working with stage presentation and generally backing local talent and drawing in talent from surrounding cities.

Why pick Carlisle instead of one of the bigger cities to start a business?

Kelley said, "I liked the small town atmosphere and wanted to get away from the pressure of a big city."

He added, "Although many do not realize it this town has a great wealth as a sort of central city."

"It is practically the only town on the main road between Maysville and Lexington."

"Also, Carlisle is very close to Mount Sterling and Flemingsburg which holds a wealth of country music talent."

Kelley will also try to draw from local talent as well. "We would like to work with the local civic organizations such as Lions Club, Chamber of Commerce, churches or any other interested parties."

A resident of Nicholas County, Darlene Power will be running the business with a title of vice-president.

She said, "I have been in the music business for 18 years now, but now have the chance to do what I always wanted to do - be as involved in recording as I can get."

Power added, "I think if God gives you a talent then you should use it, and I know there are many in Carlisle that have talent and can use it to their advantage as well as entertainment for others."

According to Kelley and Power, the new business needs support. Power said, "We would like for you the community to work with us, but we need support."

"Instead of another door shutting there will be a door open for the community."

Kelley professes that Country Roads is "here to stay" in Nicholas County. "We want to bring the Nashville sound to Carlisle and think we will be successful if we can get the support we need from the people of the community."

The new eatery, renamed, J. D. M. Country Boy Restaurant was opened July 1.

New hours for the business are Monday, 6 a.m. thru 10 p.m., Friday and Saturday, 6 a.m. until 12 a.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m. until 10 p.m.

Said Kelley, "I think the community is really going to love it."

"We are going to have live music nightly on Friday and Saturday for our customers with the Showmasters making their return to Carlisle and on weeknights, we will have a jukebox."

"Up until that time, Darlene Power will be entertaining on keyboard."

But that is not the only change for the restaurant. Kelley said, "Most probably, Marlene 'Trake' will be the new manager and I have new help coming in."

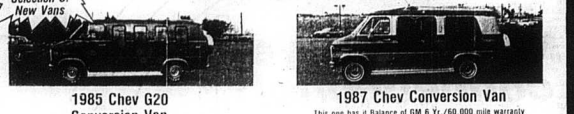
