ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1988

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF CARLISLE, KENTUCKY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1988 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1989 BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATING OF CITY GOVERNMENT

Be it ordained by the City of Carlisle as follows:

WHEREAS, a budget proposal and message has been prepared and delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed such budget proposal and made necessary modifications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE,

SECTION 1. The City of Carlisle hereby adopts the following budget for 12 months ending June 30, 1989 as follows:
