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Blackberry queen to be crowned July 7



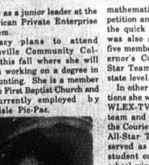
TRACY S. DOTSON

Tracy was named to the Academic All-American, KHS Who's Who Among American High School Students, and Academic All-American: KHS.

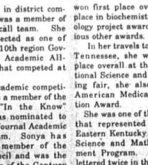

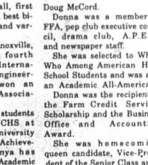


SONYA DENISE JOHNSON

Donna McCord is a 1988 graduate of Nicholas County High School and is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Donna McCord.



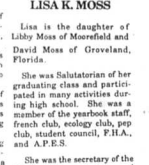
LISA K. MOSS
