Warning farmers: grass tetany

Adult beef cows nursing young calves who are grazing young grass pastures gain protein rapidly and early spring are especially susceptible to an extremely acute condition known as grass tetany. According to Diane Milach, Extension veterinarian at the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture, Lexington, grass tetany is discovered in some seasons, Kentucky farmers experience losses due to grass tetany from November to April, even as early as in the later winter and early spring when they graze heavily on the new growth of grass and refuse to eat feed...

fresh to them. Grass is especially dangerous because it is untraceable. Milk, which is a healthy sign of milk production, is a warning sign of grass tetany. Wash and soil fertility seem to be factors, he said. The disease occurs when soil temperature between 40 and 60 degrees Fahrenheit during change in weather. Alternatives to endophyte-infected fescue

Farmers who feed themselves with endophyte-infected fescue pasture, and most Kentucky cattle farmers do, have alternatives other than fumigation. Several groups came to Frankfort last week to urge the governor for change. Among those people was actress Victoria Price, who is national chairperson of the American Environmental Foundation, the successful battle for legislation that would lift restrictions in the State Medicaid Formula for certain types of abortion.

Groups also gathered in the Capitol to support William E. Barry and Senior Civilian legislation. Last week the Senate approved legislation to create a code of ethics for elected officials. It also passed another measure in support of election reform.

Senate Bill 107 may be more restrictive than was originally intended in that it may prevent any member of the House from receiving \$2,000 in any candidate from ever occupying any position in that office. The House has the impression the bill's language may be interpreted to mean that it is illegal.

Although I don't approve of the bill, I don't see any good reason why I should not support it. In other floor action, we passed bills to regulate the disposal of solid waste, including out-of-state waste. The bill may recall, some legislation in Kentucky is accepting large amounts of garbage from some of the Eastern States. This is a growing concern to many communities. The three waste-related bills we passed had previously been approved by the House. One bill requires that local courts and local government officials be notified by the state as soon as application is made for a landfill permit.
