from Day and counted a layup, and Anderson hit two free throws to make it 34-26 with 2:06 to play in the half.  
After Bourbon County had missed a shot a Brookshire attempt at three was shot and Bourbon was off and running.  
Wright hit from eight feet for Bourbon, Anderson hit one free throw for Nicholas, then Bourbon scored the

last four points of the second quarter to trail by only three at intermission, 35-32.  
After an intermission and some lockerroom adjustments, both teams returned to the floor for the final 16 minutes of regulation.  
The game, in the second half, took on an entirely different perspective, very unlike the Nicholas County-Harrison County game.

Bourbon County was the team, which was able to take advantage of Nicholas turnovers.
