Green takes 4-H trip to Washington D.C.

 Most young people in this area must find a way to achieve excellence in their specific area of interest but sometimes using only moderate resources to do so.

A Nicholas County 4-H member has received an honor bestowed upon only a fraction of Kentucky's youth.

Tina Green, a sophomore at Nicholas County High School, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Phillip Howard and late Dwight Green, was selected to attend the American Heritage Conference for outstanding 4-H members in Washington D.C.

The conference was held during spring break, from April 9-16. Green was selected to represent Nicholas County as one of 280 students statewide and one of 47 delegates from the area participants.

All participants took classes that dealt with teen pregnancy and drug abuse and had speakers from the Department of Health and Human Services and from the National Drug Administration.

Green and other Kentucky participants went to Capitol Hill to visit and speak with Kentucky's Congressmen. Green and her group also visited the Smithsonian Institute, the Jefferson Memorial, the Lincoln Memorial, the home of the nation's first president, Mount Vernon and the Arlington National Cemetery.
