Nicholas County's baseball Jackets improved to 19-7 in the 1988 season. The Jackets began play last night with a road trip to Flemingsburg. Nicholas County put away Fleming County with a five run seventh inning to take a 14-8 win. Nicholas County led 4-1 after two innings, but Fleming County fought back to trail by only one, 9-8 at the end of six, before the Jackets' last inning rally. Tip Fryman led Nicholas with four hits and four runs, while Scott Allison collected three hits, and Andy Anderson hit safely twice in the win. John Wagner improved to 4-2 on the year with the win. Nicholas County moved a seventh inning to break a 2-2 tie. Todd Day improved to 3-2 on the year, collecting 12 game winning streak for strikeouts in the win.

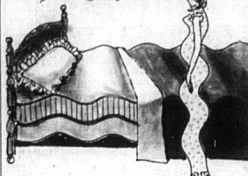
