KSP officers are honored
 LEXINGTON (AP) — Six Kentucky State Police officers were honored Thursday for bravery, gallantry and lifesaving acts.

The awards were presented at the organization's annual ceremony at a Lexington hotel.

Trooper Thomas Rosselli of the Elizabethtown post was presented the KSP Medal for Bravery for extraordinary courage. Rosselli and a Bullitt County police officer entered a burning house to rescue a man.

Trooper Carolyn Boyd of the Harlan post and Detective James Veluzot of the Bowling Green post both received the Trooper's Medal for lifesaving acts.

Boyd performed the Heimlich maneuver on a man who was choking while attending the state fair. Veluzot performed a similar maneuver on a choking victim at a Manfrotville restaurant.

LA Gary Rose and Trooper Lloyd Stapleton of the Pikeville post received the Medal for Meritorious Service for their efforts in apprehending two armed felons.

Detective Grant Adams of the Harlan post received the medal for his pursuit and apprehension of an assault suspect.

Ten people not associated with the agency received the Meritorious Achievement Award for their help to the state police.

Students learn lesson in kindness
 LOUISVILLE (AP) — Students from an Owensboro elementary school learned a lesson in kindness

when their school bus broke down en route to a field trip in Louisville.

The 26 fifth-graders from Sutton Elementary School thought their trip was over Wednesday as they sat helpless on Interstate 64 just outside of Louisville in New Albany, Ind.

"They were really upset that they were going to miss the whole thing," said Jo Ann Penrod, a program coordinator with the school district.

But the New Albany Floyd County school system dispatched a repair crew after highway workers spotted the stranded bus, and then provided the class a spare bus and driver when mechanics couldn't solve the problem.

The new bus whisked the children off to the Kentucky Center for the Arts, where they watched a performance of Macbeth. And when their bus still wasn't fixed after the play, the Transit Authority of River City sent a complimentary bus to take the students to see Kentucky Show!

Floyd County school district mechanics fixed the Owensboro bus in time to take the students to the next attraction, and only charged \$65 for towing and the substitute driver's time.

Louisville officials are upset
 LOUISVILLE (AP) — Louisville officials have their Irish up over Dublin, Ireland's decision that there is no sister-city relationship between the two.

The Irish flag was removed from the city square this week, but no one is sure what caused the bad blood between the two cities.

According to records in the Louisville archives, a sister-city agreement was made in 1976 between then-Mayor Harvey Sloane and then-Lord Mayor of Dublin James Mitchell.

However, current Lord Mayor Carmencita Hederman said there never was such an agreement. She acknowledged that letters had been exchanged, but said the city council never formally replied to twin with Louisville.

Members of the Sister Cities of Louisville Inc. were upset about the situation. But group president Terry Stacy said the organization will work on strengthening its ties with the four remaining sister cities: Montpellier, France; Quito, Ecuador; Mainz, West Germany; and Tamale, Ghana.

Ties with Dublin were not as strong as those between Louisville and some of the other sister cities. However, John Darcy, a former co-chairman of the Dublin committee, said the group may seek a new sister city in Ireland.

Downs announces contest
 LOUISVILLE (AP) — Churchill Downs and the official licensing organization of the Kentucky Derby have announced the second annual contest to design a logo for the next Kentucky Derby.

The winner of this logo contest for the 115th Run for the Roses will receive 115 \$10 bills.

The contest is open to any Kentucky resident or anyone with proof of employment in the state. The dimensions of each entry must be 12 inches by 14 inches.

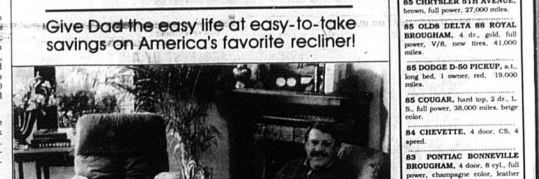
