

### Returning home Kingsolver unveils new book at Carlisle Depot reception

Barbara Kingsolver wears a silver wedding band, with a tree, a man and other symbols etched on it. She explained that the Santa Domingo Pueblo Indian ring tells a story in Indian symbol. Her husband's ring tells a different story.

After a long day of book signing, her face brightens when she talks about her husband, Robert Pulliam, and their year-and-a-half-old daughter, Camille.

It is after five o'clock and Kingsolver has been laughing, talking and remembering with well over 100 Nicholas Countians who visited the Carlisle Depot Sunday afternoon.

She puts the reporter on hold as she hugs "Papa," Roy Kingsolver. Then she talks with Catherine and Charles Camp about throwing Barbie dolls out the window.

Camp awares that Camille will never be told the story of her mother throwing dolls out the window as the teacher tried to convey a lesson.

"They really taught me a lot, it sunk in, too, despite the fact that I was a class clown," she said, glancing at her mother and father. "My parents don't know that!"

"I was extraordinarily shy and clowning was a way of fitting in."

"I think that part of my persona developed into storytelling," she said. "Wanting to entertain."

Earlier in the day, Laura Humphrey, Kingsolver's first grade teacher made an appearance.

Teachers are obviously important to Kingsolver and are also important to the main character of her popular first novel, "The Bean Trees."

Taylor Greer refers to Hughes Walter, a science teacher, as someone who changed her life.

Juanita Conley, who organized the book signing, ordered 75 copies of the book from Harper and Row, think

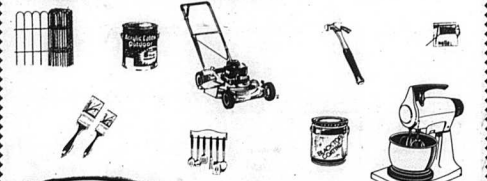
