Junior Lady Jackets take big win over Belmont

Nicholas County's junior lady Bluejackets girls eighth grade team pulled away from a 12-0 halftime lead and held on to down Belmont 26-25, last Thursday.  
The loss handed Belmont, by the 5-1 Nicholas County squad, was the first in the past two seasons.  
Belmont went undefeated last season, capturing the Conference Tournament by one point over Nicholas.

Christie Hutton led the Nicholas County attack with 11 points, while hauling down 12 rebounds. Nikki Smoot pitched in five points for the winners, while Kim Denkins grabbed seven rebounds and shipped in with 5 points.  
Nicholas County led at all steps, 9-2 at the end of the first quarter and 20-13 at the end of three periods.  
"There's no doubt good out-

front defenses end size (Kim Denkins 6-foot-2, seventh grader) inside make all the difference in our play," said Nicholas County's Head Coach Barbara Kenner.  
"We have maintained pressure on the ball and the turnovers have helped us in winning."  
In the seventh grade game - Nicholas County rallied from a 15-12 Belmont lead at intermission to go ahead 23-19 after three quarters and out scored Belmont 12-4 in the final frame to post a 33-21 win.
