Senator Ed Ford speaks to Nicholas County teachers

Ed Ford, state senator from Nicholas County teachers on the topic sparking so much controversy across Kentucky. Insurance, which has led to walk-outs and protest marches in other areas, has become a touchy subject, as the Blue Cross Blue Shield coverage teachers have enjoyed will come to an end November 1.

"We have a crisis," Ford said, likening the new package to a pay cut. The teachers will receive fewer benefits, but the cost will be higher.

The current plan is to begin a self insurance package called "Kentucky care." Money will be put into a pool, \$124 a month for teachers, and that will be used to pay claims. Ford said the outlook is grim for this plan, estimating that the General Assembly will have to make a supplemental appropriation next year.

Social Security Update

Q. I've been going to the chiropractor for a number of years for a back problem. I just started getting Medicare. Will Medicare pay for my visits to the chiropractor?
A. The only chiropractor treatment covered by Medicare is manual manipulation of the spine to correct subluxation that can be demonstrated by X-ray. This treatment must be furnished by a licensed and Medicare-certified chiropractor to qualify for Medicare coverage. Medicare does not pay for any other diagnostic or therapeutic services, including X-rays, furnished by a chiropractor.

The governor, Wallace Wilkinson, has been asked to put the insurance issue on his call for November and January, Ford said, but thus far no one has been successful in convincing him.

"We are on your side," Ford said, referring to the teachers. Tuesday, October 19, there will be a teachers rally in front of the Paris Court House. Teachers from seven area counties are being urged to attend.

Ford also discussed the governor's education plans.

He asked to teachers to help sell the concept that those with children in school are being cheated by not being taxed.

"You must convince them (the taxpayers) that you get what you pay for," he said.
