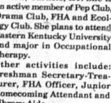
Melissa Sexton, Grade 12, daughter of Lee and Carolyn Sexton. Activities: Girl Scouts and Pep Club.

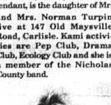

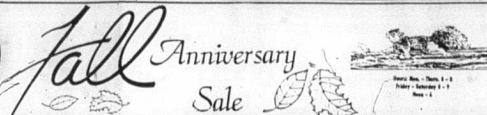
