Wildcats hand Nicholas County loss Friday

OWINGSVILLE - Friday's game, played in a mist at Bath County High School looked to be a shut out, but Nicholas County rallied in the fourth quarter, making the final score 45-4.

The Bluejackets came out raring to go, but as Bath County struggled down field, they also wore down the Jack-ets defense.

Nicholas County allowed the Wildcats within yards of their goal, after a first down the Cats were able to go in for their first touchdown with 3:46 left in the first quarter.
