Burley crop is progressing

A majority of the 1989 burley tobacco crop has reached the midway point in the growing cycle, and to date, its progress is considerably behind schedule, according to crop specialists.

This year, many tobacco farmers have experienced an extreme turnaround from the drought conditions they were witnessing last year, and now too much water is causing the most extreme halfway through the normal 90-day growing season.

Excess moisture in most of the eight-state burley belt this season has made the 1989 crop "extremely variable," said Dr. Gary Palmer, extension specialist with the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture.

"We're seeing all sizes from the top to wait-high-... Tobacco experts also are expecting this year's crop to cost more to produce. Additional nitrogen is being side dressed to plants to...
