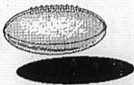

Nicholas County will be facing this season.

**Fleming County** - "Though they have lost their backfield from last year, they have an experienced line. But I think their backs should be quicker this year."

This game will be our first test and it should be a tough game. It will exploit our strengths and our weaknesses which we will adjust and improve over the rest of the schedule."

**East Carter** - "This is the first time we will face East Carter in about 12 years or so. But, I have heard from other coaches that this is one of the best teams they have had in years. They are big and they are strong."

**Mason County** - "Several key players are returning from last year and they have added some good athletes. As a disciple of Coach (Ben) Pumphrey (a former NCHS coach), I know the team will have a potent attack. They have good speed, we will have to be prepared for what they do. I've always admired the way Pumphrey prepared a team for an opponent. I hope I can do at least half as well."

**Frankfort** - "Coach Raymond Webb has boosted the morale of the Frankfort football program and they are expecting a very good season."

**Berea** - "Berea has changed head coaches and the team is supposed to be small. But this is no cause for celebration. If we un-

derestimate this team, we could be handed a loss. To be competitive, Nicholas must realize there are no automatic wins."

**Paris** - "They are the district favorite and the early indications I have heard is their talent alone will enable them to have a banner year. They have many good athletes with a lot of size and speed."

**Bourbon County** - I do not have a preliminary scouting report on them yet. They have a new team and I won't make the mistake of taking them lightly."

**Madison Southern** - "They are a brand new district opponent though it is said they will move to double A next year. They have an enthusiastic squad with big numbers. It is the team we must beat to have hopes of a

playoff berth."  
**Lewis County** - "They have lost several seniors from last year, but they are well coached. When we face them, they will be bringing a complete offensive - defensive package for us to contend with."

**Bath County** - "I have a lot of respect for this team. Whatever team they have, they will line up toe to toe and come at you with everything they have. They have lost some key players, but it is also a team we must beat."

**Harrison County** - "Because this is the last game of the season, it will be a good test of Nicholas County's character. They are very well coached."

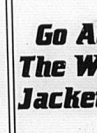
