**Jackets sting Bearcats, 67-62**

Brown, but after Bearcat Chad Crouch, fouled by Travis Sims, made one of two shots from the line. Sims made up for his mistake with a long three pointer from far left court to bounce Nicholas County ahead 3-1.

Anderson, however, held on to its lead more from foul shots than the field, but at 4:27, Sparks rebounded Sims shot and tied the game at 21, then went to bring the Jackets the lead with two foul shots and a 23-21 advantage.

Johnny Shouse came up with two points to tie the score, but Brown, despite being double teamed, slid under the basket to count a bucket.

Wills and Simons set up a beautiful bounce pass play to set up a score with five seconds left on the clock, but it was Anderson's Kelly Peach final to shots to end the first half with Nicholas ahead 34-31.

David Sparks found himself too well covered to try and make a shot, so instead he tossed the ball out to Hlander who canned another three point basket to make it 11-8, as the Bluejackets threatened to regain the lead.

Shouse attempted to bring Anderson back into breathing room with a quick two pointer, but Brown answered in kind with a three point shot bringing the Jackets within two.

Morris sank a two pointer to bring the Jackets to 41 points, but Anderson kept up the pressure matching the Bluejackets shot for shot to stay within one point.

Shouse gave Anderson its first lead of the second half with a three point jump shot to make the score 44-41 to end the third quarter.

In the final eight minutes of regulation, Brown passed to Hlander for a score, but the shot missed. Sims rebounded and plugged the basket to make it 44-43.

The lead changed hands for a few minutes until Sparks stole the ball away from Stivers and was fouled when he went for a layup which set up a three point play to put the Jackets up by two and Anderson could not find the steam to re-take the lead.

Brian Stivers plugged two foul shots to end the quarter with Anderson on top, 15-13.

Bearcat Jimmy Morris opened the second quarter with two foul shots to push the Anderson lead to four and Stivers made it five points with a foul from Jarrod Wills, but Brown ended Anderson's control rifling a three pointer from the right side of the court to bring the Jackets within one, 17-16.
