

## MSU rallies for season's third win

**CLARKSVILLE, Tenn. (AP)** — Morehead State quarterback Chris Swartz passed for 170 yards as he eclipsed the school passing record previously held by Phil Simms (NFL New York Giants quarterback) and led the Eagles to a 23-22 Ohio Valley Conference victory over Austin Peay Saturday.

Swartz now has passed for 5,598 yards during his career as compared to Simms' old record of 5,245 yards.

The Eagles (3-5, 1-3) came from behind, lapping Austin Peay (0-8, 0-3) when Mitch Fedak hit a 28-

yard field goal with 10:49 remaining in the game.

Austin Peay led 13-7 at the half and the Eagles trailed 22-20 going into the final quarter.

Austin Peay built its first half lead on a 12-yard run by Sammy Gholston in the first quarter and a 6-yard return of a blocked Morehead State punt by Kerry Severson. The Governors missed their extra point attempt following Jackson's touchdown.

Morehead State's only first-half point came on an 8-yard run by Chris Turk.

Austin got a 5-yard scoring run from Mike Lewis and a 24-yard

field goal by Grad Wright in the third quarter, while Morehead State countered with two Swartz scoring passes of 18 and 5 yards to Anthony White.

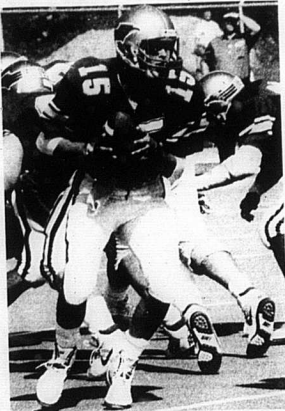
