A vocal opponent of standardized testing for elementary children from kindergarten to third grade, Dr. Marium Williams said she and many other educators have joined in criticizing the state's standardized testing program.

Williams objects to standardized testing in these grades because, she said, the tests are too complicated in their arrangement for younger children to understand or appreciate.

"I looked over the general achievement test for kindergarten and found areas where the test was more complex and difficult to take than either the first or second grades, especially in reading comprehension," Williams said.

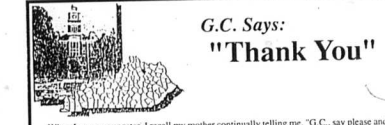
