

### EKU drops second in a row

ORLANDO, Fla. (AP) - Sophomore Rudy Jones threw two fourth-quarter touchdown passes and Franco Grilla kicked the game-winning extra point with 6:55 left in the game to lift Central Florida over Eastern Kentucky 20-19 Saturday night.

The Knights (6-3) defeated the fourth-ranked NCAA Division IAA Colonsels. It was Eastern Kentucky's second straight loss after being ranked No. 1 in Division IAA two weeks ago.

Jones brought the Knights to within six points with a 4-yard pass to Mike Dickinson and completed the game-tying 39-yard touchdown pass to Sean Beckles. Grilla's point after kick put the Knights in front with 6:05 remaining in the game.

The Knights' defense held the

Colonsels to their lowest point total of the year.

Junior Mark Giamone led the Knights in rushing with 51 yards on nine carries and one touchdown, but the big story was the emergence of Jones, who made nine completions on 15 attempts for 120 yards and two touchdowns, with one interception.

Tailback Mark Thomas led Eastern Kentucky in rushing with 192 yards on 27 carries.

James Campbell got the first points on the scoreboard for Eastern Kentucky with field goals of 27 and 35 yards. Central Florida led 7-6 at halftime.

Rick Burkhead scored in the third quarter for Eastern Kentucky on a 16-yard run. Thomas then scored on a 10-yard run but the two-point conversion failed.
