**NCHS girls prevail in Paris Pan-O-Rama**

CARLISLE — Nicholas County High School in conjunction with Kentucky Textiles, the primary sponsor, will host the second annual basketball Pan-O-Rama at NCHS, November 25.

Lee Cruise, boys head basketball coach at Nicholas County, said last year's games offered spectators plenty of excitement, and this year's event promises no less.

This year's games format will take on a more different structure from last year with four girls teams invited to participate.

The games will begin at 11 a.m. with Edell County and Fleming County. This will be a girls game.

At 12:30 Lewis County boys take on St. Patrick.

At 2 p.m. Buchanan County will battle Williamson.

At 3:30 p.m. Tolson boys will play Madison Southern.

The last two games of the day will be Nicholas County girls against Montgomery County (5 p.m.) and NCHS boys versus West Carter (6 p.m.).

Each game will be composed of two 15 minute halves.

The scrimmages will allow each team the opportunity to take an overall look at preparedness, before the 1989-90 season begins.

Kim Denkins opened the scoring for the Lady Jackets with inside jumper followed by Tary Earlywine jumper to take a 4-0 lead.

Chastity Shepherd guined in a three pointer to cut the score to 4-3 with 5:48 remaining in the first. Nicholas outscored the Lady Devils 7-0 to extend its lead to 10-3.

Shepherd scored a layup off a steal for Deming and Earlywine connected on two free throws for a Nicholas lead of 10-5.

Kelly Thompson hit a jumper from the left for Deming. Kristie Barton connected on two free throws for the Lady Bluejackets, and Kristen Gifford ended the first quarter with two free throws to end the first quarter 14-9.

Nicholas came out the second quarter fired up to outscore Deming 8-0 in the first two minutes.

Thompson fired in a jumper for Deming. Earlywine earned two charity losses, and Thompson connected two free throws for Nicholas lead of 20-12.

Coach Barbara Kenney was slapped with a technical foul at the 2:30 mark of the second quarter.

Deming only managed one point by Thompson after the technical to cut the lead to 20-14.

Christie Haxton ended the quarter with one free throw as Nicholas led 21-17 at the half.

Earlywine hit three jumpers for Nicholas, Shepherd and Gifford boomed in a three pointer each and Amey Lowdenback hit off a rebound for the Lady Devils as the Lady Bluejackets 39-25 with 3:37.

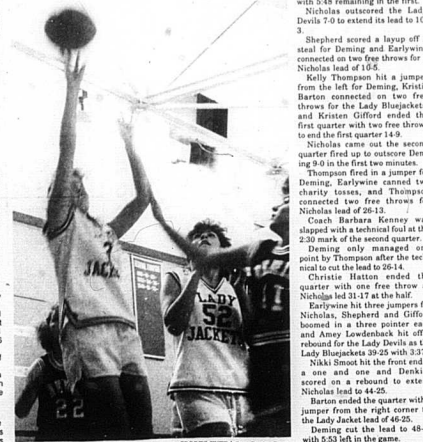
Nikki Simot hit the front end of a one and one and Denkins scored on a rebound to extend Nicholas lead to 44-25.

Barton ended the quarter with a jumper from the right corner for the Lady Jacket lead of 46-25.
