**Despite early 14-0 Nicholas lead; Bourbon rallies to take 19-14 win**

PARIS - The Nicholas County Bluejackets were handed bitter defeat Friday night against the Bourbon County Colonels, 19-14. The Bluejackets began their attack right at kickoff with Jason Brumback following good lead blocking, finding the hole and taking the ball for a touchdown. Jebson Farah took down Eric Tooney on the next kickoff and after only a five yard gain on first down the Colonels fumbled the ball setting up the Bluejackets for another surprising attack against a strong Bourbon County defense.

A screen pass and an off tackle run by Brumback led to a first down. Penalties worked for rather than against the Bluejackets this time that led to the next as the combination of a successful pass reception by Farah and a 15 yard Nicholas against the Colonels gave Nicholas a first down and put them within scoring range. After Randy Hayes scratched out four yards and Raymond Brown, running up the middle, gained another first down, quarterback Daniel Brown threw a high lofting pass to Brumback in the end zone to up the score to 12-0. Daniel Brown's pass to an open Brian Hilderer added two more

points to make the score 14-0 in the first quarter. Bourbon County's Ben Wright returned the ensuing kickoff 25 yards. Bourbon's offense suffered only once when quarterback Steven Ferrell fumbled the hike, but recovered before Nicholas could get near to take possession. A screen pass followed which took the entire Nicholas County defense by surprise, leaving Jeff Stumper with a wide open field for

the Colonel's first score on the evening. The extra point kick went just a little to the right, but was still good enough to up the Colonels' to seven points.

The Bourbon defense turned themselves around and held the Bluejackets to the line of scrimmage, which, after a delay of game penalty against the Bluejackets, forced them to punt at 4th and 14.
