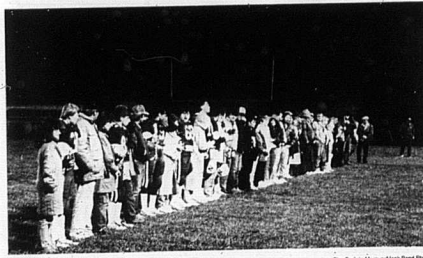

Russell to catch up and bring Brown down.  
But the Bluejackets would not get that much further.  
Even backed up by an illegal motion penalty, Toiles ran the score in for 26, then 30 points on the board.

Raymond Brown did run for good yardage on the kick-off return and a short pass to Hillender got the Jackets within four yards of the first, then advance stopped.

Bath could pick and choose this series as they made first down yardage in the air and on the ground. Todd Carpenter made several big runs spinning off arm tackles followed by Quon Wilson scoring for 36 points. The extra point attempt was thwarted.

Raymond Brown came up with the largest gain of the evening as he doubled back on the Wildcats and outran the defense to about the 40 yard line, when starter step forced him to slow enough for the Wildcats to catch him. A personal foul against

Bath gave the Bluejackets additional yardage and it seemed for a moment they would maintain an un-shutout record. But Raymond was then sacked in the backfield and could not gain more yardage. On a pitch on third down, the ball was fumbled and Bath recovered.

Daniel Brown recovered a full back's fumble to return the ball for Nicholas County's last possession, but the ball was intercepted by Wilson to end any possible scoring threat.

"It was a matter of a more experienced and confident team facing a relatively younger group that made the biggest difference in the game," Head Coach Greg Leitcher said.  
But he said Bath County made most of their yardage on big plays and there were times when the defense played well against the team.

Nicholas gets a week off before facing Harrison County in Oystertown November third at eight.

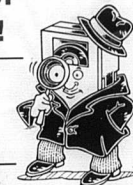
