Nicholas Comprehensive Care has important role

By Mike Lichman Special to the Mercury The Nicholas County Comprehensive Care Center located in the basement of the courthouse in Lexington, offers mental health services to children, adults, mentally retarded individuals, and mental health problems. According to Jan Hitching, team leader of the center, the agency offers a host of programs designed to combat any mental health concern a citizen of Carlisle may have.

Among those services offered to children (when applicable) and adults are individual and group therapy, family therapy (involving working with their parents to alleviate a problem, etc.), marital counseling, and substance abuse counseling. Whereas most children and adults are seen at the comprehensive care center, those persons who suffer from chronic mental health problems are seen at the Harmony House in Paris.
