Jackets travel to Paris

Nicholas County will face the 2-2 Paris Greyhounds Friday night at Paris High School.

Though ranked highly in the state, Coach Greg Letcher said Paris plays basic, predictable football with little in the way of deceptive plays, though the quarterback is capable of making good fakes.

"They are not likely to throw many complicated plays as us," Letcher said. "The key to them is good athletes. They have two strong running backs and an exceptional quarterback who is as likely to run the ball himself as give it away."

To take them, Letcher said, the Nicholas County line will have to be prepared to meet Paris head to head and not give anything away by mistakes.

"We can have no penalties because Paris will capitalize on them effectively."

"We have one small break in that two of their starting players will not be allowed to play. But still they will be as tough a team to play than we have seen all year, there is no denying that, but they can be beaten if we are willing to give everything we can to play full speed, head on, tough football," Letcher said.

Morehead takes first

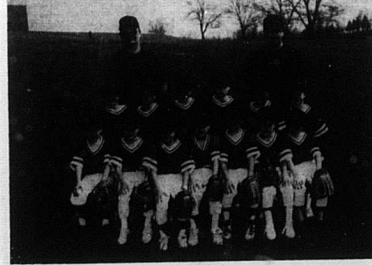
MOREHEAD, Ky. (AP) — Chris Swartz threw for 251 yards and three touchdowns to Ty Howard, who tied a school record for most scoring receptions in a game, as Morehead State defeated Kentucky State 38-0 Saturday night.

The Eagles, 1-1, scored late in the first half and on their first three possessions of the second half to pull away from Kentucky State, 0-3. Howard caught touchdowns passes of 4 and 12 yards in the second quarter as Morehead took a 17-0 halftime lead. Mitch Fedak accounted for the only scoring in the first quarter with a 35-yard field goal.

Howard hauled in a 7-yard TD pass in 21-point outburst by Morehead in the third quarter. Jerome Williams ran 3 yards for a touchdown and Anthony Jernice capped the Eagles' scoring with a 17-yard burst.
