

## Fleming Co. through Harrison Co. schedule filled with strong teams

**CARLISLE** — Nicholas County Head Football Coach Greg Letcher took a look at the upcoming Nicholas County football schedule and had these comments.

**FLEMING COUNTY** — "A power football team that runs the washbone. This is a tough game. They are always competitive and always play tough defense."

**EAST CARTER** — "This will be the first time in several years that we have played them in Grayson. They lost 24 seniors from a team that went 11-0 last year. I know they play a 53

defense but I'll have to look at the films and study them."

**MASON COUNTY** — "One of the better teams on our schedule. They have a big offensive line and a 245 fullback who they like to run."

**HARRODSBURG** — "This is a new team on our schedule. They're blessed with quality athletes. This is a tradition-rich Class A school that was in the state finals three years ago. A well-disciplined, quality team."

**PARIS** — "One of the top two or three Class A teams in the state. Well coached

**BOURBON COUNTY** — "They're a 2A school with a new coach. I know all of their backfield people are back. This should be a good team."

**MADISON SOUTHERN** — "A district opponent which will move up to 2A next year. They lost several seniors but it's a new school and they have a lot of kids."

**LEWIS COUNTY** — "A well coached team. They will do a lot of things offensively, a lot of formations and trick plays. Always a good club who lost some talented play-

ers from last year."

**BATH COUNTY** — "A power football team. They have been tremendously successful the last two years. They come out prepared to attack."

**WEST CARTER** — "Another new team on the schedule. I don't know a lot about them. They're returning some good players and are in the process of building their program."

**HARRISON COUNTY** — "This school made the state playoffs last year and opens this year with Danville in the Rector-ting Bowl. They have a lot of quality athletes."
