SOCIAL SECURITY UPDATE

Q. I recently received a statement from Social Security showing my earnings. The totals do not agree with mine. How can I get this straightened out? A. It shouldn't be hard to do. Just contact the people at a convenient Social Security office and submit proof of your additional earnings. You can use items such as your tax returns, W-2 Wage and Tax Statements, or pay stubs to establish the fact that you made more than our records show. Your records will then be corrected. And by the way, this points out a good reason for checking your earnings record every five years. If there is a problem, your current records will be corrected.
