Fifth annual fair to be held at NCES

For the last five years the Nicholas County Elementary School has sponsored the school Science Fair and this year promises to be a very competitive. Harry Spickler, co-sponsor to the science fair,

Spickler, who co-sponsors the project with colleague Pat Atkinson, said approximately 208 entries from all elementary school grades will be featured in the fair. It begins officially Wednesday, March 21 with judging running through the entire school day. The fair opens to parents and public from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Awards will be given the following day, K-3 at 9:30 a.m., grades 4-6 at 1 p.m., and 7-8 at 2 p.m., Thursday.

Participation is slightly lower than usual, Spickler said, partly because the deadline for projects were on shorter notice than last year. But the projects are varied and Spickler feels judging will be close.

Twelve judges, some from Nicholas County and others from outside, will begin judging after students have set up their projects on Tuesday.

Awards will be given on three levels in four categories: Best individual projects, physical and biological; Best group science projects, physical and biological.

Individual winners from the fourth through the eighth grades may go on to the Regional Science Fair at Morehead State University later this Spring.
