Blue Licks to hold celebration

The last battle of the Revolutionary War will be fought again August 15, 16, 17, and 18 at the Blue Lick State Park, Carlisle, Kentucky.

The Maysville Flyers, in conjunction with the Blue Lick State Park staff, will present the Simon Kenton Outdoor Drama. Performances will start Thursday, Friday, and Saturday at 9 p.m. and Sunday at 7 p.m.

Advance tickets can be purchased in Carlisle and Hopkins Drug Store and Albee's Blue Licks Grocery. Admission for Adults is \$3.00 and Children 12 and under \$1.00.

Tickets are on sale at the park prior to each performance. The drama features a re-enactment of the famous revolutionary battle in which Daniel Boone fought. On August 19, 1782, the Cherokee, Mingo, Wyandot, Delaware, Chippewa, Ottawa, and Shawnee tribes under the leadership of British Captain Caldwell routed a pursuing force of Kentuckians at Blue Licks. This battle is called the "Last Battle of the Revolution". Members of the White Hawks Primitive Riflemen from Carlisle, Kentucky and the Kenton Spies and Mounted Militia from Manchester, Ohio will participate in the re-enactment.

The Outdoor drama was written by Marion Waggoner and chronicles the exploits of an early settler, Simon Kenton.
