Frank Terrell, Commander of the Lloyd George Post, is chairman of a committee which is planning the preparation of a suitable memorial to be placed on the courthouse lawn listing those Nicholas County service members who lost their lives during the listed combat actions.

The Fiscal Court has granted permission for the creation of the memorial, and VFW will provide the funding for the project.

A detailed search has been made of available sources to attempt to establish an accurate listing of the war dead. Terrell is requesting that the list of names that has been developed, and listed below, be reviewed and corrections, additions, or deletions be provided to him as soon as possible.
