REPORTING PERIOD
January 1, 1991 - February 28, 1991

Property owners are required to report all
property (Real Estate, Tangible & Intangible)
to the Property Valuation Administrator's of-
fice during this period. This will enable the
PVA to make corrections where necessary to
real estate and possibly prevent omitted tax
bills on Intangible and Tangible property.
Items to be reported regarding Real Estate
include: new houses or any addition to existing
houses, baths, garages, carports, storage
buildings, swimming pools and barns.
Mobile Homes sold during 1990 or moved to
a different location must be reported. The size
and cost of new mobile homes must also be
reported if in the county on 1/1/91.
Buildings lost by fire, wind, etc. should be
reported to allow adjustments in assessment
if necessary.
Farm sales should be reported, partial sales
in particular. New owners must apply for Agri-
cultural Exemption by 3/1/91 or the Prop-
erty will be valued on Fair Cash Value for
1991.
Property owners who will become 65 years
of age during 1991 and live in their homes
must apply for the Homestead Exemption
during the listing period. Anyone qualifying
for TOTAL DISABILITY through Social Secu-
rity, Federal Government or Railroad can ap-
ply for the Disability Homestead Exemption
regardless of age.
The listing of your property may be done at
the PVA Office, basement of the Courthouse,
from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays 9:00 a.m.
to 12:00 noon on Saturday during January
and February. You can stop by at your conve-
nience or call 289-3735 for an appointment.

items of needed equipment
thoroughly, before the need of
them arises. He also points
out the need for good record
keeping.
The farmer needs to keep
records of when the calf is
delivered along with which cow
is the dam and how difficult
the birth is. Then when it
comes time to cull some of the
older cows out of the herd the
farmer knows which ones to
start with. We have the record
books here at the extension of
"file".
What advice does Phillips
have for the home gardener
who might want to get ahead of
the game?
Winter is a good time to
check out the equipment so you
won't get out there and find
that the tiller won't start. It's
also wise to go ahead and pick
out what varieties of seeds
might be needed and order
them. This avoids the rush
and in the event that the vari-
ety might be new or in short
supply assures the gardener of
getting the seed he wants."
