Worthington begins quest for statewide office

FRANKFORT — On January 31, State Representative Pete Worthington (D-Bowling Green) announced his intentions to lead the charge for the Democratic nomination for the Lieutenant Governor's office.

The first point of Worthington's plan is to terminate all of the legislative duties of the Office. This will result in a savings of over one-quarter million dollars.

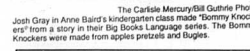
