

REPRESENTATIVE REMARKS

During week three of the 1991 special, issues requiring attention from legislators were beginning to form a definite nucleus. Several committees that received bills have begun to scrutinize the provisions of the legislation and conduct public hearings.
These House Committees with bills have activated the legislative process. They include the House Committee on Appropriations and Revenue; Economic Development, Education, Elections; Elections and Constitutional Amendments; Judiciary, Natural Resources and Environment and State Government.
The House Committee on Appropriations and Revenue has already approved the Budget Paper Incentive Package in December and is also passing the full membership of the House.
Appropriations and revenue will more than likely receive the Delta incentive package as well as the coal severance tax legislation.
The Economic Development Committee is considering the legislation codifying into law the basic principles of settled cases law relating to nuisance claims.

Small herd not what it appears to be

CYNTHIANA — Geoff and Leslie Behnes are owners of a non-descript farm tucked away in the northeast corner of Harrison County. At first glance, the farm animals appear to be your normal, garden variety.
On closer observation, however, you will find what appears to be a small herd of ponies.
Leslie refers to them as "her pets."
Don't be fooled by these small creatures; they are not ponies at all, but a rare breed horse known as the Swedish Gaited.
Standing only 11 to 13 hands tall (44 to 52 inches) they are one of the rarest breeds of horses in the United States.
Best accounts show only 20 to 25 individuals in the U.S. The Behnes' own 10 horses were bred on their own island off the coast of Sweden.
They were bred and used for all the typical horse uses, even trotting races.
Records show they go back as far as the Vikings, where the tough, little breed was used to carry warriors into battle.
Leslie describes the breed as intelligent, willing and

friendly, making the horse a good choice for young riders who might be intimidated by the normal sized horse.
These horses are also strong and are equally able to carry an adult or pull farm equipment.
Individual Gaiteds have also been trained for jump racing.
Today, the Behneses are most concerned with raising the numbers of the breed and promoting the breed as a tribute.
To talk to the family I'd say the little horse has a superb chance of making a come back.
